

Syntax




Syntax

▶ `fp = fopen(“filename”, “mode”);`



Modes



Modes

- ▶ **w** - creates file for read and write



Modes

- ▶ **w** - creates file for read and write
- ▶ **r** - opens file for reading



Modes

- ▶ **w** - creates file for read and write
- ▶ **r** - opens file for reading
- ▶ **a** - writing at the end of file
