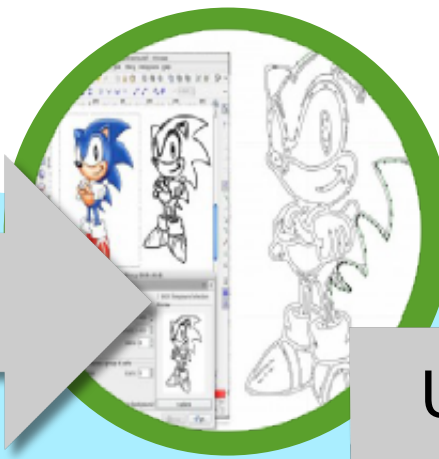


Introduction



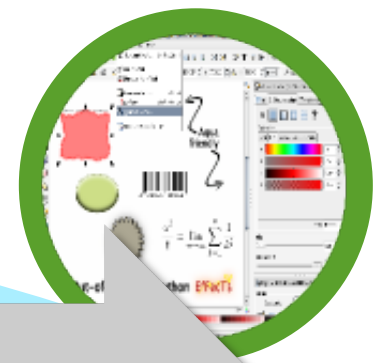
- Inkscape is a Free and Open Source alternate to Adobe Illustrator and Corel Draw.
- It is a vector graphics editor.
- Works on Linux, Mac OS X and Windows.
- Imports and exports SVG, PDF, Ai, JPEG, PNG, GIF etc.

Features



- Create objects using Rectangle tool, Polygon tool etc.
- Manipulate objects using Grouping, Cloning.
- Transform objects using rotating, scaling, skewing.
- Color objects using Color palette, Fill and stroke.
- Draw paths using the Bezier tool and the Pencil tool.
- Manipulate text using Manual kerns, Superscript and Subscript.
